The Authority has received request for clarifications on the above tender and would like to respond as follow,

NO	CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS	CA RESPONSE
1.	Warranty for Growatt Single-Phase Hybrid Inverter: The specified requirement indicates a 7-year warranty, while the standard market warranty for the Growatt single-phase hybrid inverter is typically 2 years. Could you please advise if we should consider purchasing an extended warranty to meet the 7-year requirement?	<i>The Authority wishes to change this requirement for Growatt Single-Phase Hybrid Inverter from seven (7) year warranty to two (2) years warranty</i>
2.	Manufacturer's Authorization Form (MAF): Section ITT 6.2 states that an MAF is required. However, the preliminary and technical evaluation criteria do not specify this requirement. Could you please confirm if the MAF is mandatory, and, if so, clarify whether it is required for each of the following components:	<i>The Authority wishes to clarify that Manufacturer's Authorization Form (MAF) is only mandatory for the solar panels and inverter.</i>

ALL other conditions of the tender remain unchanged.
