To All Bidders,

**RE: PROVISION OF CLEANING, FUMIGATION, AND DISINFECTION SERVICES AT  
THE CA REGIONAL OFFICES AND REMOTE STATIONS**

Please refer to the above-mentioned tender.

Pursuant to ITT 9.1 of the tender document shared with bidders, the Authority wishes to respond to the clarifications sought out as follows:

NO.	CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS	CA RESPONSE
1.	<p>“We would like to address an issue concerning Clause MR 7 in the Mandatory/Preliminary Evaluation Stage, which requires bidders to provide valid County Government Business Permits for the respective counties being bid for, specifically Nyeri, Mombasa, Kisumu, and Uasin Gishu Counties”.</p> <p>As a company that does not have physical premises in these counties, yet operates within these regions, this requirement places us at a disadvantage, as we are unable to provide the required business permits. In light of this, we would kindly request that the clause be amended. Specifically, we propose that if a company wins the tender, it should be allowed to establish an office in the relevant county and provide the required County Business Permits at that time</p>	<p>The mandatory requirement remains unchanged, and bidders are required to comply with it.</p>
2.	<p>Kindly look at the General provisions, Clause no.3 ,Legal notice no. 121, Environmental Management and Co ordination (waste management) Regulations 2006 which provide that;</p> <p><i>....any person whose activities generate waste has an obligation to ensure that such waste is transferred to a person who is licensed to transport and dispose off such waste in a designated waste disposal facility....</i></p> <p>We have arrangements with a licensed waste transporter to handle waste in our work sites.</p> <p>Question; For the purpose of compliance with mandatory requirement No. MR6, may we attach our waste handlers NEMA certificate and the teaming agreement?</p>	<p>CA as the waste generator is obligated to ensure that it has contracted a service provider who meets the requirement. In this case, the bidder, who is a potential contracted service provider must have the NEMA Certificate as required.</p>

**ALL other conditions of the initial tender remain unchanged.**
