

Nairobi officials appeal sacking

TWO finance officers fired by the Nairobi county last month have appealed their sacking.

Former finance chief officer Jimmy Kiamba and head of treasury Stephen Osiro were sacked on July 13 for neglecting duties. County public service board chairman Philip Kung'u yesterday said the board and the office of the county secretary are considering the appeals.

"I cannot say when we will give the verdict," he said.

Before the sacking, the two were on suspension pending trial for defrauding City Hall out of millions of shillings in procurement deals in April.

But Kung'u told the Star that the grounds on which the two were sacked were different from the charges they are facing in court.

Suspended county secretary Lilian Ndegwa is also facing graft charges.

Eight varsities told to fix campus flaws

EIGHT university campuses in Nairobi have been given six more months to make up for shortcomings revised by the Commission for University Education.

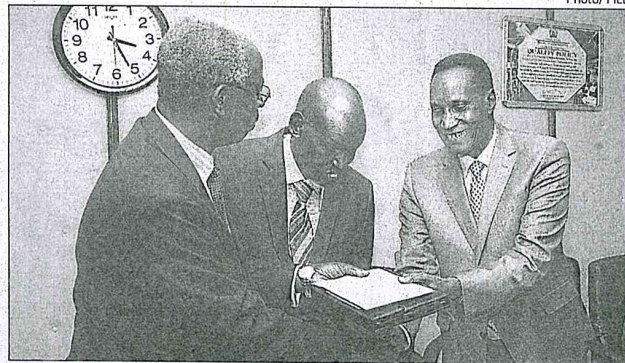
The campuses were to be closed in December but now have a July 2016 deadline.

An advertisement signed by the commission chairman Henry Thairu said seven out of the eight universities appealed against a June 18 public notice of closure after six months, and were given an extra six months.

"The universities requested for more time to address the issues raised during the inspections of their campuses in January and February 2015," he said.

An appeals committee formed by the commission considered the petitions.

Further consultation among the Education ministry, CUE and the affected universities agreed that 12

months would be adequate for the universities to address the issues raised during the inspection.

The 12-month period took effect from July 31.

The satellite campuses continue with operations and also seek to comply with the Universities Regu-

lations, 2014, and Standards and Guidelines, 2014.

The university campuses are St Paul (Church House), Egerton University (Stan-Bank House), Africa Nazarene (Argho and StanBank houses) and South Eastern Kenya (Development House).

Others are Dedan Kimathi University of Technology (Union Towers), Multimedia University (City Square Post Office Building), Masinde Muliro University (Kingsway House) and Jomo Kenyatta University of Science and Technology (Westlands Campus).
