PREQUALIFICATION FOR PROVISION OF LEGAL SERVICES

The Communications Authority of Kenya (CA) is the country's ICT regulator with responsibilities in telecommunications, e-commerce, broadcasting and postal/courier services. CA is also responsible for managing the country's numbering and frequency spectrum resources.

The Authority invites interested, eligible and competent firms to apply for pre-qualification to provide Legal Services for the period ending 30th June 2016.

The Authority will select qualified firms for its panel of external lawyers in accordance with the method of selection specified in the pre-qualification documents. Law firms with a partner who has been conferred the status of Senior Counsel are encouraged to apply.

Interested and eligible firms may obtain pre-qualification documents from the Procurement Office at the CA Centre along Waiyaki Way, Nairobi, during working hours. The pre-qualification documents will be issued to interested firms at no cost.

Completed tender documents should be submitted in a plain, sealed envelope clearly marked
