

The DVB-T2 Digital Television signal is now on air.

Here is your chance to invest in Kenya's
great digital migration.



The process of migrating from analogue to digital TV broadcasting is on course and the digital DVB-T2 signal is now available in Nairobi and its environs. In Kenya, approximately 4 million analogue TV sets will require mandatory connection to DVB-T2 set top boxes in order to receive the digital signal. This presents a huge business opportunity to suppliers, distributors and retailers.

Firms interested in importing DVB-T2 compliant set top boxes may obtain the specifications from CCK offices or from http://www.cck.go.ke/about/downloads/Public_notice_fp2.pdf. Those intending to import digital set top boxes and digital TV sets (digital TV sets with inbuilt DVB-T2 tuners) for sale in Kenya must first obtain type approval from CCK.
